

Public Notice

The Village of Rantoul will host a public hearing to receive citizen input concerning the Village's formulation of a Substantial Amendment to its 2019 Annual Action Plan for Community Development Activities. The plan on housing and community development activities describes the Village's design for utilization of federal funds administered by the Department of Housing and Urban Development identified under the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program. The Amendment proposes to allocate the additional \$81,299 in CARES Act CDBG-CV Round 3 funds recently received by the Village to the new activity Household Emergency Assistance Program. The Household Emergency Assistance Program is designed to provide funds to assist qualified Village residents who meet the HUD low-moderate income limits and can demonstrate how the COVID pandemic has impacted their ability to make timely utility payments with grant funds to pay up to 3 months of past due utility bills to ensure that residents do not have to have utilities turned off or risk becoming homeless.
