SUMMARY HIGHLIGHTS: Open Space Lands Acquisition and Development (OSLAD) is an annual grant program offered through the Illinois Department of Natural Resources (IDNR). This grant program provides up to 50% (90% for distressed communities) funding assistance to acquire and/or develop public outdoor recreation areas. With the completion of the Heritage Lake Master Plan in 2019 (concept plan included in packet), we have the ability to submit a competitive application to the IDNR. The concept plan was led by ERA/Upland Design and developed with public input at the Heritage Lake committee meetings, which were held on January 24, March 7, May 13, and June 24 of 2019. After reviewing the concept plan cost summary, as well as the recommended project components in the grant manual, staff feels that submitting a more diverse list of projects versus our 2019 submittal will enhance our chances of being awarded. With the application deadline approaching, the estimated cost of project components is still being researched, but the projected components of the project include: • 10' Wide Aggregate Trail (approximately 1 mile): \$240,000 • Remove and Replace East Shelter: \$135,000 • New Playground Construction: \$200,000 • Associated Grant Expenses: \$60,000	

- Total: \$635,000

To complete the application and to be fully considered, a Resolution of Authorization (Form OS/DOC-3) must be completed and signed, indicating the Village of Rantoul has the funding to complete the proposed project.

RECOMMENDED ACTION: Staff recommends that the board approve the Resolution of Authorization to complete the application.
