1. Commissioner Schurter called the meeting to order at 1:00 p.m.

2. Public Comments

- a. No public comments.

3. Approve Minutes

- a. Commissioner Schurter made a motion to approve the minutes of the regular meeting held Wednesday, October 19, 2022. Commissioner Igartua seconded the motion. The Board voted unanimously to approve the minutes as written.

4. Old Business

- a. Commissioner Schurter inquired about the Sergeant testing, and Deputy Chief Bouse advised that all went well and as planned.
- b. Chief Brown added that since the physical fitness amendment, a candidate was unsuccessful in completing the power test requirements. He asked if the candidate should then be removed from the list, or maintain their place on the list and be eligible to take the power test for future open positions. The Board members agreed candidates should remain on the list.

5. New Business

- a. Deputy Chief Bouse gave an update on new hires. Michael Floyd couldn't successfully complete phase 2 of his field training program, which led to his resignation. Ashley Hatfield resigned due to incompleteness of the power test required for PTI enrollment. Casey Smith graduated PTI December 15, 2022 and is currently in phase 2 of her field training program. Katelyn Riffle was hired December 19, 2022 and is currently enrolled at PTI. She is scheduled to graduate April 27, 2023.
