Officer Richard Little is currently enrolled in PTI and is expected to graduate on August 24th. Officer Kaleb Kraft is a lateral hire from Gibson City PD that started his accelerated FTO program on July 3rd. Officer Kyle Schlorff is another lateral hire from Mahomet PD that will begin his accelerated FTO program on July 31st. He, also, mentioned that they are in the process of investigating the background of four applicants and hope to hire two applicants to send to the September PTI class. They will soon be losing an officer to McHenry County Sheriff's Department, which will leave a vacant SRO position to be filled.
