1. **Commissioner Schurter called the meeting to order at 1:01 p.m.**
2. **Public Comments**
 - a. No public comments.
3. **Approve Minutes**
 - a. Commissioner Schurter made a motion to approve the minutes of the regular meeting held Wednesday, October 18, 2023. Chairman Sherrick seconded the motion. The Board voted unanimously to approve the minutes as written.
4. **Old Business**
 - a. Deputy Chief Bouse gave an update on the new hires. He informed the Board that Officer Rich Little completed his FTO program and has been on his own since December. Deputy Chief Sullivan advised that written exams are scheduled for February 8th and 10th, and would like to have a date set for oral interviews with the Board soon after that. The Board members agreed to schedule oral interviews on February 16th. Deputy Chief Bouse added that they are hoping to get 2 new hires to send to PTI in May.
5. **New Business**
 - a. Chief Brown suggested an amendment to the rules and regulations regarding the eligibility list, but after clarifying the interpretation of the language with the Board, it was agreed the amendment was not needed.
