Items for Consideration

Mr. McCoy reported on the Fiscal Year 2024 Budget outlook, along with the five-year Capital Plan. The Comprehensive Plan update includes remedies for a "100-Year Storm" detention, along with planned Capital improvements utilizing the Illinois Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity grant funding.

Mr. McCoy shared the proposed storm drainage improvements for the downtown area, which would utilize America Rescue Plan Act funding and coincide with the Downtown Streetscape Project. The Project should break ground in the Spring of 2024.

Mr. McCoy reported details of the proposed Cheryl Drive project, which is included in the five-year Capital Plan.

Mr. McCoy shared a video and photos from the Oakcrest/Pinecrest Area Storm Drainage. The Schlueter's Storage area created a V-shaped ditch that follows the back side of the buildings, which outlets to a new eight-inch storm sewer line

that carried the access out beyond the structure and has stayed out of neighboring backyards to date.

Mr. McCoy reported that Champaign County, Village of Rantoul, and Triple Fork have worked on a project to improve the double box culvert near Heritage Lake.
