Items for Consideration

Mr. McCoy stated that homes on Illinois Drive were demoed in the Summer of 2021. The next step for Storm Drainage is to create a detention basin on site, which would cost approximately \$400,000.00.

Mr. McCoy shared a video and photos from the Oakcrest/Pinecrest Area Storm Drainage. The Schlueter's Storage area located to the West has seen improvements made by Dirtworks. Dirtworks created a V-shaped ditch that follows the back side of the buildings, which outlets to a new eight-inch storm sewer line that carried the access out beyond the structure and stayed out of backyards.

Mr. McCoy reported that Champaign County, Village of Rantoul, and Triple Fork have worked on a project to improve the double box culvert near Heritage Lake.

Mr. McCoy shared other Village Storm Water Topics including the industrial area ditch clean-up, which has \$5,000.00 budgeted for the winter and \$20,000.00 planned for Fiscal Year 2024 budget. He also shared future planned improvements with the Illinois Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity grant, and the Capital Projects schedule for the next five years.
