1. **Chairman Sherrick called the meeting to order at 1:03 p.m.**
2. **Public Comments**
 - a. No public comments.
3. **Approve Minutes**
 - a. Chairman Sherrick made a motion to approve the minutes of the regular meeting held Tuesday, October 15, 2024. Commissioner Igartua seconded the motion. The Board voted unanimously to approve the minutes as written.

 - a. Deputy Chief Bouse gave an update on the new hires. He informed the Board that Officer Johnathan Grice & Officer Armando Romero completed their FTO program and have been on their own since November. Officer Shanice Guider resigned before completing her FTO program. Kyle Nierenhausen started PTI January 6th, and new hire, Darius Webb failed the POWER test and has been put on administrative leave pending the passing of the POWER test the end of March. Upon passing, he will attend PTI in May. Also, they interviewed a lateral applicant just that morning.
 - b. Deputy Chief Bouse advised the Board that \$2,000 was added to the budget for Sergeant testing the fall as the current list expires in December. Chairman Sherrick made a motion to approve the proposed budget for FY25-26. Commissioner Igartua seconded the motion. The Board voted unanimously to approve the proposed budget.
 - c. Deputy Chief Sullivan informed the Board that there will be a written exam for new applicants administered on February 1st and 5th, and oral interviews will need to be scheduled shortly after that. Since Commissioner Schurter was absent, Chairman Scherrick suggested sending an email to get a date set that works for all three of them.
