NAYS: None – 0.

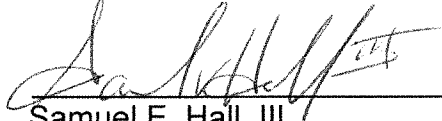

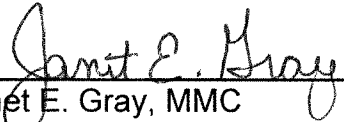

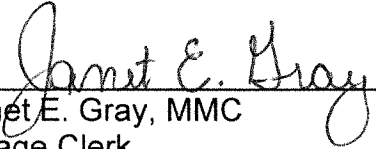
