NAYS: None – 0.

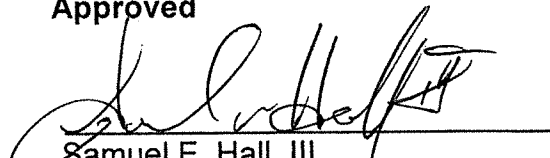

The motion carried 5-0.

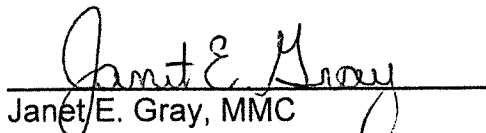

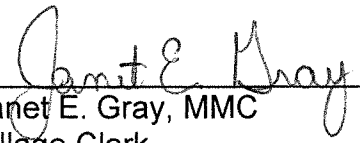
