

**RANTOUL VILLAGE BOARD OF TRUSTEES
REGULAR BOARD MEETING
NOVEMBER 12, 2025**

A Regular Meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Rantoul was held at 6:00 P.M., President Hall presiding. President Hall called the meeting to order.

Invocation & Pledge of Allegiance

Rev Otis Evans of the Greater New Light Missionary Baptist Church opened the meeting in prayer. Following the invocation, Trustee Wilson led the audience in recitation of the Pledge of Allegiance.

YEAS Wilson, Graham, Robertson, Haines, Workman and Crider – 6.

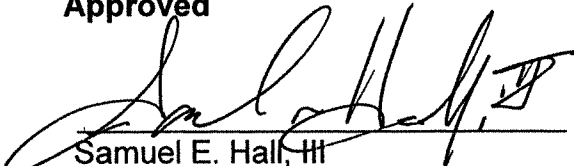

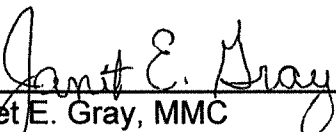

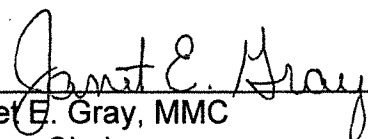
